


MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: AMC/AMSC Expiration for AMCOM Spare/Repair Parts

1. In order to provide the Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) a more precise date for the AMC/AMSC expiration of AMCOM weapon system spare/repair parts, an expiration date has been added to the ICAPP Procurement Usage File. The expiration date can be used to determine need for rescreening of spare/repair parts procurements.
2. The ICAPP-generated expiration dates are based on previous AMCOM guidance regarding valid time periods for AMCOM-assigned AMC/AMSC screening codes with the following exception: For Critical Safety Items (CSIs), where the Command or DLA is buying to a part number with no STDP document provided, the validation period has been changed from 2 years to 3 years. For CSIs in which an STDP document is provided, the AMC/AMSC validation period remains at 2 years. This change is reflected in the ICAPP AMC/AMSC expiration date.
3. Programming changes to ICAPP have been implemented. A Software Configuration Control Board request has been submitted to update the PRETECH module in ILTMARS so that PRETECH programming will reflect the updated validation period for CSIs with no STDP provided.
