Colonel Deirdre A. Mahon is the site commander of DLA Aviation's Customer Operations at Hill Air Force Base in Ogden, Utah. DLA Aviation is a field activity of Defense Logistics Agency, Fort Belvoir, Va.

DLA Aviation is the aviation demand and supply manager for Defense Logistics Agency with more than 3,300 civilian and military personnel in 19 locations across the United States. DLA Aviation supports more than 1,400 major weapon systems and is the U.S. military's integrated materiel manager for more than 1.4 million repair parts and operating supply items.

Positioned alongside its military customers, DLA Aviation manages industrial support activities at Robins Air Force Base, Ga., Tinker AFB, Okla., Hill AFB, Utah, Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point, N.C., Naval Air Station North Island, Calif., and NAS Jacksonville, Fla.

DLA Aviation also manages depot-level repairable procurement operations at Robins, Tinker and Hill Air Force Bases; Naval Supply Systems Command (NAVSUP) Weapon Systems Support, Philadelphia; and at Redstone Army Arsenal, Ala.

DLA Aviation also operates an industrial plant equipment repair facility at Naval Supply Systems Command (NAVSUP) Weapon Systems Support, Mechanicsburg, Pa.

Col. Mahon serves as the single DLA face to the customer for all DLA organizations at Hill Air Force Base and is responsible for the daily operations of all retail-level supply, storage and distribution support.



Colonel Mahon received her commission in 1987 upon completion of Officer Training School in San Antonio, Texas. She began her Air Force career as an information management officer and cross-trained into the Logistics Plans career field in 1996. She is a two-time squadron commander and has held positions at all levels of the Air Force, to include Air Staff.

Prior to her current assignment, Col. Mahon was the 460th Mission Support Group commander, 460th Space Wing, Buckley Air Force Base, Colo. Her responsibilities included providing administrative and personnel support to Air Force Space Command units and other units and agencies in the Front Range area. The group provides civil engineering, security and protection, logistics readiness, contracting, military and personnel support, education services and family support services to personnel assigned to the 460th Space Wing, as well as personnel throughout the Front Range area. Col. Mahon also served as chief, Distribution Operations Division, at Headquarters Defense Logistics Agency, Fort Belvoir, Va.

Colonel Mahon holds a Master of Science degree in management from Troy State University, Europe, and a Master of Science degree in national resource strategy from the Industrial College of the Armed Forces, Fort Lesley J. McNair, Washington, D.C. She also holds a Master of Military Operational Art and Science degree from the Air Command Staff College, Maxwell Air Force Base, Ala.
