

DLA On-Line Map Catalog Now Available Through MEBS

Effective 17 Sep 2012 mapping customers can access the DLA Map Catalog (DMC) online account via the Mapping Enterprise Business System (MEBS). MCO has partnered with the DMC Team to enable one stop sign on when you have a MEBS Account.

Personnel currently with a MEBS account will be automatically integrated into the system. Once activated, you will receive two separate emails from dllisacctmgmt_dev@dla.mil. One containing a User ID, the other a Password token. You will be required to access the DMC site one-time to synchronize your Common Access Card (CAC) with the DMC. If you do not have a CAC, or do not wish to use it, you may use the password and log on ID instead.

New customers will be automatically given the role to access the DMC when they register in the Account Management and Provisioning System (AMPS) for their MEBS role. New managers will also have the same requirement to complete a one-time registration to synchronize your Common Access Card (CAC) with the DMC.

The DMC requires that you access the catalog site once every 30 days to maintain a current status. If you do not, your account will become inactive and you will need to contact the DMC team to have your password reset.
